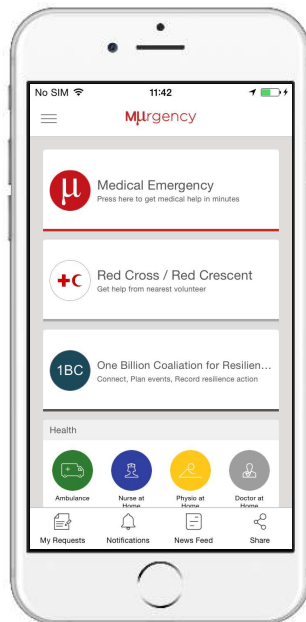



Scope – 1BC/MUrgency app




- Extend MUrgency app to include 1BC use cases:
 1. **Register** 1BC members & RCRC first responders
 2. Allow 1BC members to **record** the actions they take to build resilience
 3. **E-mobilization:**
 - Mobilize 1BC members to collectively build resilience in their communities
 - Mobilize validated RCRC first responders to assist in individual emergencies
 4. **Integrate** with other 1BC apps as part of digital ecosystem (e.g. First Aid & Hazard apps)
- Global instance, some configuration by NS (e.g. RCRC first responder validation)





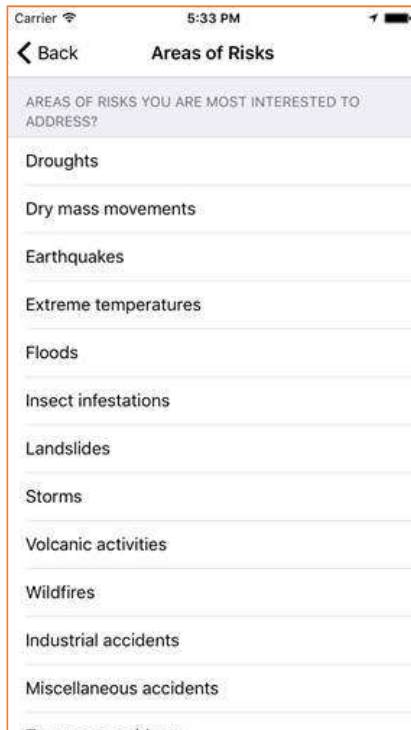
1BC Member Welcome Email & Certificate

- By default, when 1BC users register they get 1BC welcome email + 1BC member certificate

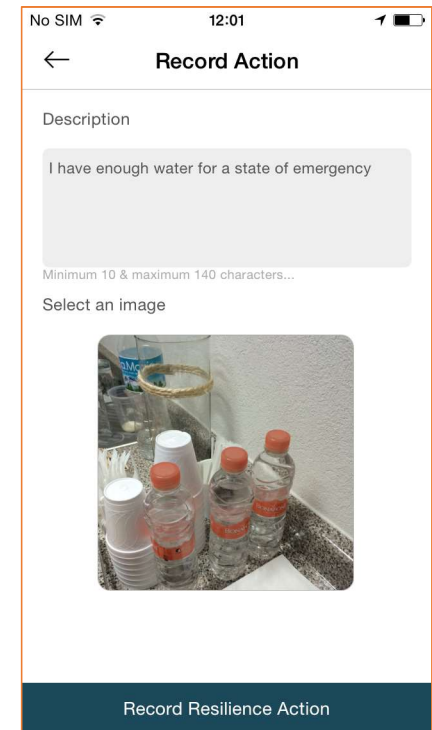
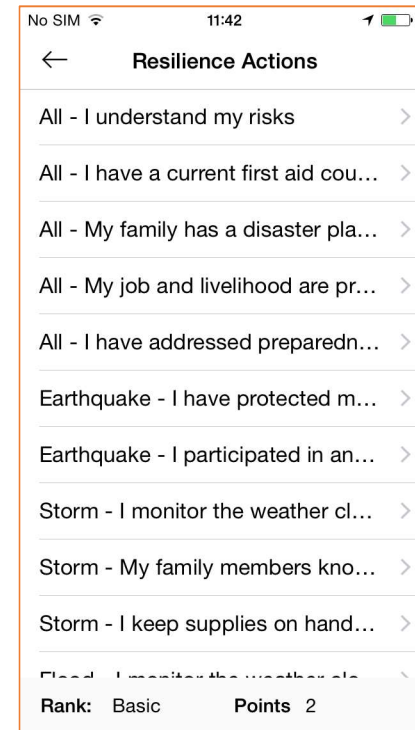
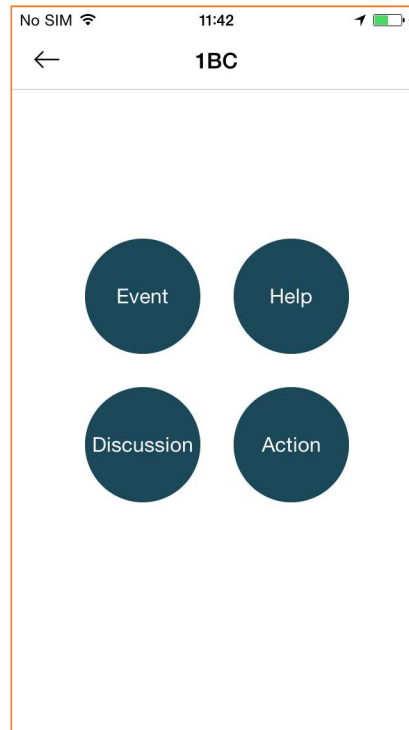


Recording Resilience Actions

Users then select the actions that they either plan to take or have already taken.



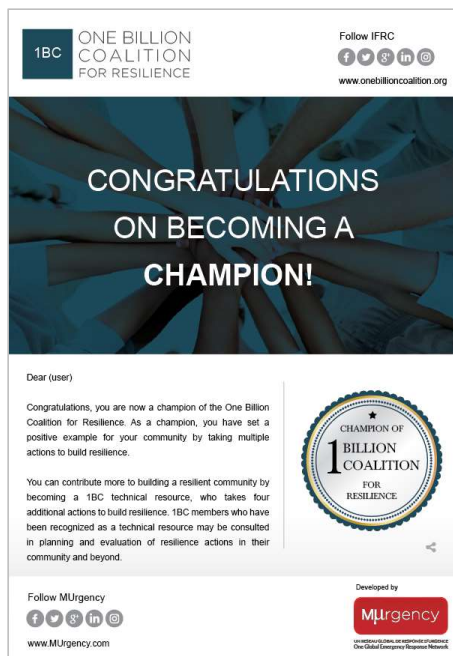
1BC Member Status / Badges

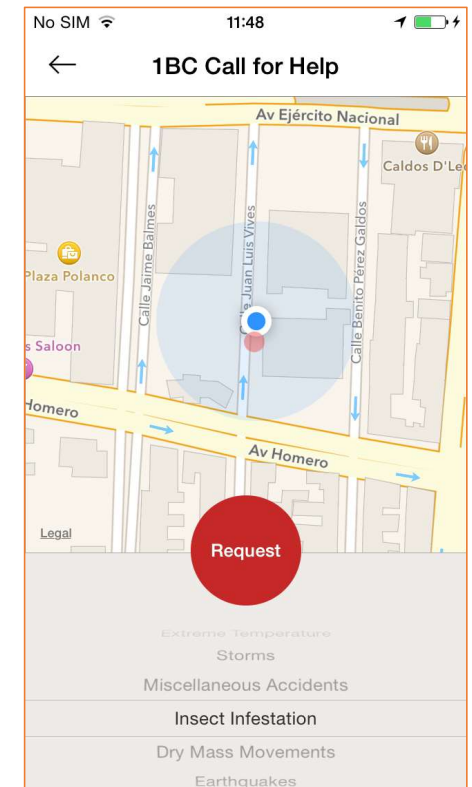
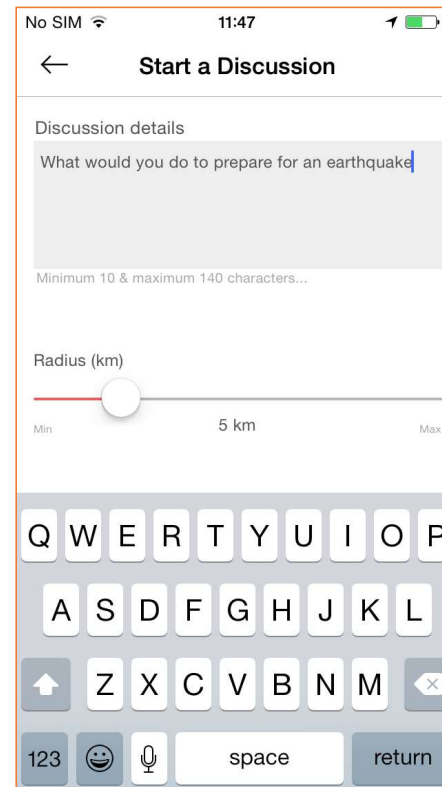
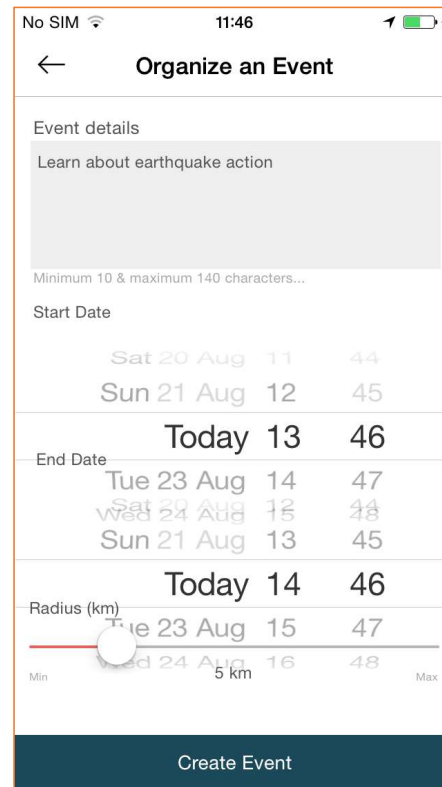
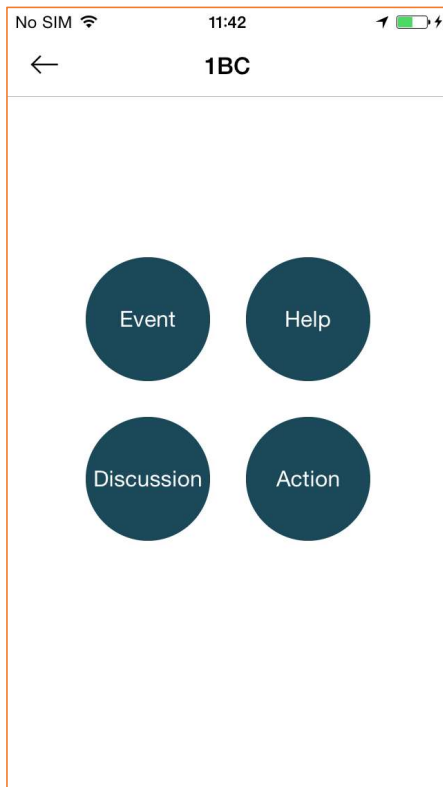
Mobilize 1BC Members



- Drought

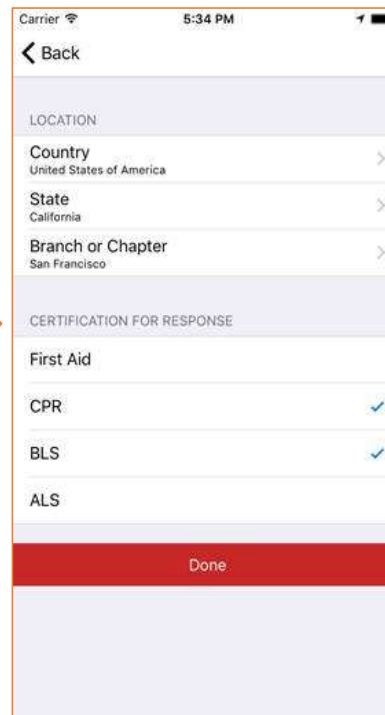


Register RCRC first responders

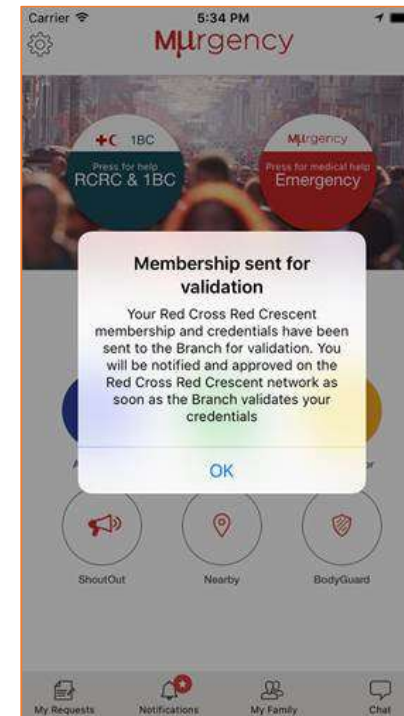
During 1BC Registration, user will be asked if he/she is an RCRC member/volunteer.



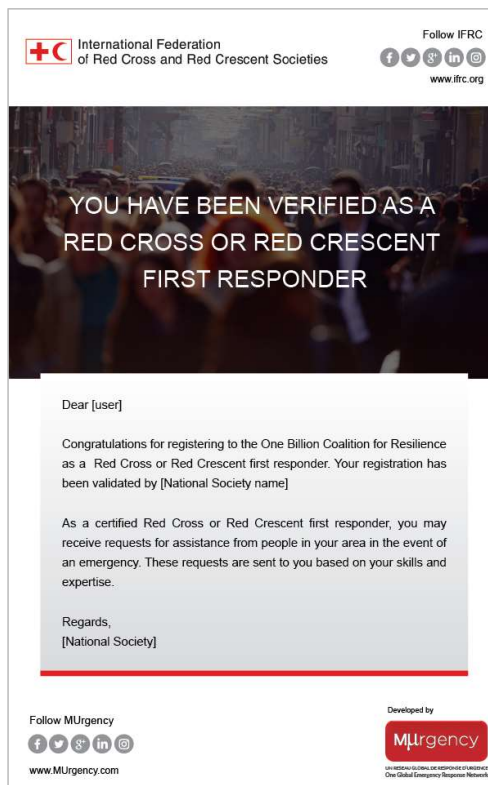
User selects location & certificates.



NS is notified to validate the user's RCRC membership & certificates.



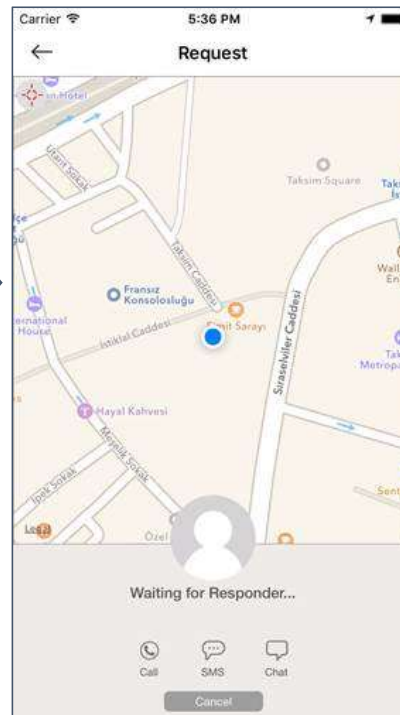
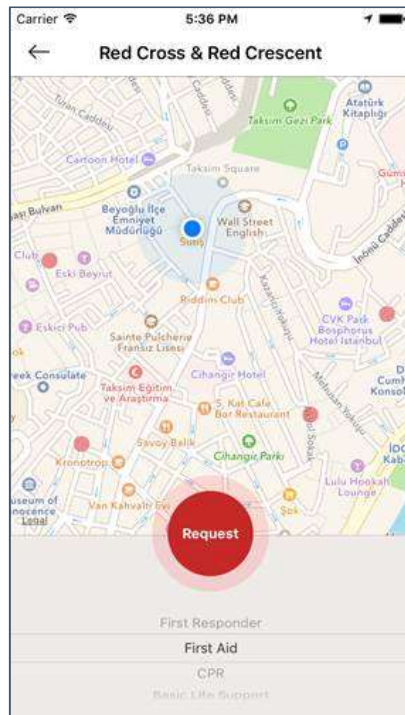
RCRC First Responder Validation Email



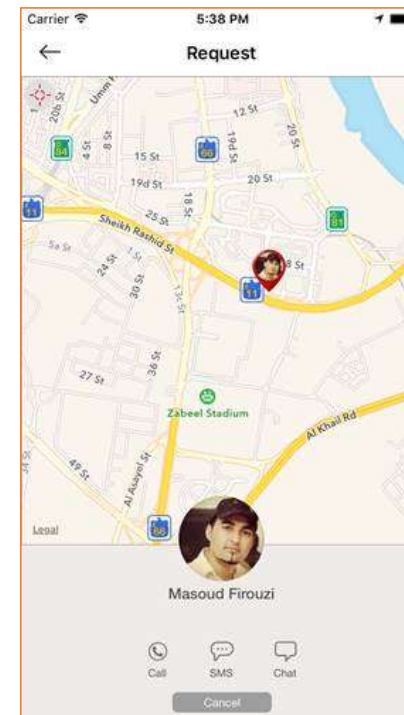
- By default, when a RCRC volunteer registers, his profile will be sent to his branch for validation
- After validation, the RCRC volunteer gets a welcome email
- Welcome mail is branded with IFRC logo for now, with the name of the NS. It is planned to brand this with NS logo in the long term.

Mobilize RCRC First Responders


User sees if RCRC responders are available in the area and request for assistance.



RCRC responder will get a notification, accepts request, & communicates directly with user.
