Coalition Building in Cities

The world is changing. The far-reaching impacts and hazards of climatic variation and sea level rise mean we need to focus on urban resilience challenges, especially in coastal areas.

There is a need to experiment and find new ways of working with others in urban contexts.

The Global Disaster Preparedness Center (GDPC) has developed and tested tools and



services to help Red Cross Red Crescent National Societies to increase city-wide collaboration around climate-smart resilience and coastal risk reduction. The program has been piloted by National Societies in Vanuatu and Indonesia and is currently underway in Myanmar.
