A World Bank report 2015 has revealed that about 234,000 people, including 80,000 died in urban areas due to environmental pollution and health risks in the past 20 years. That's 10 times more than the death in a road accident that year, which was 21,286, is noted.

The report revealed more that South Asia was the most polluted region in the world and that global air pollution was responsible for more deaths than known risks such as malnutrition, road accidents and physical inactivity

For millions of years, we are using environment on this earth to survive, to be benefit ourselves and to make money. For many centuries, there was very little time to think about our environmental responsibilities to save the environment, save the world, to preserve its resources for future generations.

The concept of using our limited resources efficiently is very recent. Decades have passed since we realized that we have to take care of our environment, we need to be wise about using resources like water, trees, fossil fuels, etc.
