Knows and manages its risks	<p>... the flood early warning system (EWS) is functional.</p> <p>... people expect the next flood may be worse than previous floods.</p> <p>...schools teach about deforestation.</p>	<p># months that the EWS was active in 2015.</p> <p>% people that are not optimistic.</p> <p># hours/months that ecosystem disaster risk reduction is taught in schools.</p>
2. Is healthy	<p>... the household has attended a first aid training.</p>	<p># households that successfully passed first aid training in 2015.</p>
3. Can meet its basic water and sanitation needs	<p>...the household has and uses a latrine.</p>	<p># households that have access to a latrine in their home (measure annually).</p>
4. Can meet its basic shelter needs	<p>... the household has a roof made out of X material.</p>	<p># households with roof of X material (measure annually).</p>
5. Can meet its basic food needs	<p>...the household eats three meals a day.</p>	<p># households that consumed three meals a day last week</p>
6. Has diverse economic opportunities	<p>Community to add examples</p>	<p>Etc.</p>
7. Has well-maintained and accessible infrastructure and services	<p>Products are sometimes unavailable in local shops.</p>	<p># days/months when supply not available</p>
8. Can manage its natural assets in a sustainable manner	<p><i>Community to add examples</i></p>	<p><i>Etc.</i></p>
