ENGAGING YOUTH IN CLIMATE ACTION PROGRAM

Between November 2023 and June 2024, BDRCS, through its' Disaster & Climate Risk Management Department, launched the Engaging Youth in Climate Action Program in Khulna and Bagerhat.

A key aspect of the program was Y-Adapt, a Red Cross Red Crescent Climate Centre curriculum, which trained youth leaders and volunteers in 9 coastal Bangladesh communities, equipping them with knowledge and skills to design, lead and implement local climate initiatives.
