#### The Urban Climate Resilience Program

(UCRP), 2023-2026, brings together global actors including the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC), ICLEI, C40 Cities, R-Cities and Plan International to develop climate resilience initiatives in urban contexts in nine countries around the world. Funded by the Z Zurich Foundation, the Australian Red Cross, together with Zurich Australia, is leading UCRP in Western Sydney.

Inaugural Extreme Heat Awareness Day, engaging **3.3+ million people** nationally through TV, radio, online, print, and social media, as well as in-person engagement, with the support of more than 80 organizations.

#### **HEAT SMART CITY PLAN**

Collaborative development of the Heat Smart City Plan as part of the Heatwave Taskforce led by the **Western Sydney Regional Organisation of** Councils (WSROC).
